

ICAR-Indian Institute of Water Management organized a three days training programme for the front-line functionaries of NGOs and farmers from Sambalpur during 1-3, February, 2023

A three days training on “**Soil and water conservation measures for enhancing water productivity**” was organized during 1-3, February, 2023 to the front-line field functionaries from different NGOs at ADARSHA training center, Golabandha, Maneswar block, Sambalpur, sponsored by PRADAN.
