"Swachhta Hi Sewa 2019" (11 September – 02 October 2019) on 28th September 2019

ICAR-Indian Institute of Water Management, Bhubaneswar organised seminar as a part of "Swachhta Hi Sewa" on 28th September 2019. The Director and staff of ICAR-Indian Institute of Water Management participated in the seminar on 'Plastic Waste Management in India' delivered in Committee room. The speaker explained about status on plastic production, consumption, plastic waste generation and steps (Reduce, Reuse, Recycle, Recovery and Landfill) involved in plastic waste management in our country. Further the speaker informed the different ways for getting beneficial items like park benches, dust bins, plastic coated bitumen for road construction, textile garments, plaston for construction of toilets, pavement bricks through recycling process; recovering energy from plastic waste for cement and other industries. During interaction, staff members discussed type of plastic safe for food materials, how best each one contribute in reduction of plastic waste and reusing of plastic materials.
